

TRAVEL SUBSIDY FORM

Subject to available funding, the National Centre for Truth and Reconciliation (NCTR) is able to offer a limited number of travel subsidies to attend lessons learned and remembering the children memorial register events.

Please be advised there is only a small number of subsidies available on a first come first serve basis. We anticipate a large number of survivors will attend the event, so please note there is no guarantee that a subsidy will be provided.

Travel subsidies are available for Survivors who are traveling greater than 25 km driving distance to the event to a maximum of \$150 per person. Preference will be given to those survivors who live outside of the city, to ensure there is surrounding community representation.

To be eligible, applicants must:

• Attend either a lessons learned or memorial register event

Priority will be given to applicants who:

- Are Residential School Survivors
 - Are Intergenerational Survivors
 - Require only a partial subsidy
