



My ReconciliACTION Plan – example for Royal Proclamation and the covenant of reconciliation (45-47)

- Learn and Understand by** Reading about the *Royal Proclamation of 1763*, the *Treaty of Niagara of 1764*, and other historic Treaties in Canada.
- Explore by** Learning about wampum, Treaties, and about the early relationships and negotiations between Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples.
- Recognize by** Acknowledging the efforts of the British Columbia Treaty Commission which advocates for Indigenous rights and title through the negotiation of modern treaties.
- Take action by** Supporting the Office of the Treaty Commissioner to promote respect and understanding of Treaties.
- Teach by** Sharing Treaty education resources, like *Kinikinik*, a play commissioned by the TRCM from Ian Ross.

Learn and Understand: Read about the *Royal Proclamation of 1763*, the *Treaty of Niagara of 1764*, and other historic Treaties in Canada (<https://www.rcaanc-cirnac.gc.ca/eng/1100100028574/1529354437231>). Explore: Learn about wampum, Treaties, and about the early relationships and negotiations between Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=carZhqsK6iA>).

Recognize: Acknowledge the efforts of organizations like the British Columbia Treaty Commission (<https://www.bctreaty.ca/>). The Commission advocates for and facilitates the recognition and protection of Indigenous rights and title, through the negotiation of modern treaties.

Take action: Support organizations like the Office of the Treaty Commissioner (<http://www.otc.ca/>). The vision of the OTC is to promote respect and understanding of Treaties and to support Treaty parties in maintaining and enhancing the Treaty relationship.
