- Learn and Understand by** Watching the documentary, *Doctrine of Discovery: Stolen lands, Strong Hearts* about the Declaration.
- Explore by** Learning about *Bill B-15, An Act respecting the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples*.
- Recognize by** Reading articles about the implementation of the Declaration from Indigenous scholars in *UNDRIP Implementation: More Reflections on the Braiding of International, Domestic and Indigenous Laws*.
- Take action by** Engaging with the *Doctrine of Discovery: Stolen lands, Strong Hearts* study guide and keeping pressure on faith groups to reject the Doctrine.
- Teach by** Sharing Pam Palmater's podcast episode with Brenda Gunn and the Honourable Murray Sinclair, *Understanding UNDRIP & Bill C-15*.

Learn and Understand: Watch the documentary, *Doctrine of Discovery: Stolen lands, Strong Hearts*, developed by the Anglican Church of Canada (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=mQwkB1hn5E8>). This documentary explores the impact of the Doctrine of Discovery and terra nullius on Indigenous and Settler people worldwide.

Explore: Learn about *Bill B-15, An Act respecting the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples* (<https://parl.ca/DocumentViewer/en/43-2/bill/C-15/royal-assent>). This Act is to affirm the Declaration as a universal international human rights instrument and provide a framework for its implementation.

Recognize: Read articles about the implementation of the Declaration from Indigenous scholars in *UNDRIP Implementation: More Reflections on the Braiding of International, Domestic and Indigenous Laws* (<https://www.cigionline.org/sites/default/files/documents/UNDRIP%20II%20Special%20Report%20lowres.pdf>).

Take action:

1. Engage with the *Doctrine of Discovery: Stolen lands, Strong Hearts* study guide (<https://www.anglican.ca/primate/tfc/drj/doctrineofdiscovery/studyguide/>); and
2. Keep pressure on faith groups to repudiate the Doctrine of Discovery and terra nullius.
